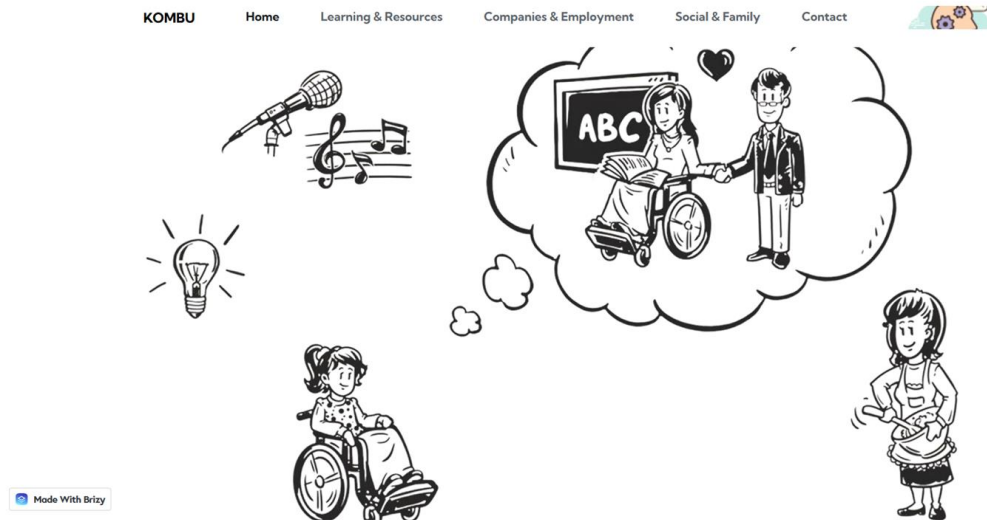

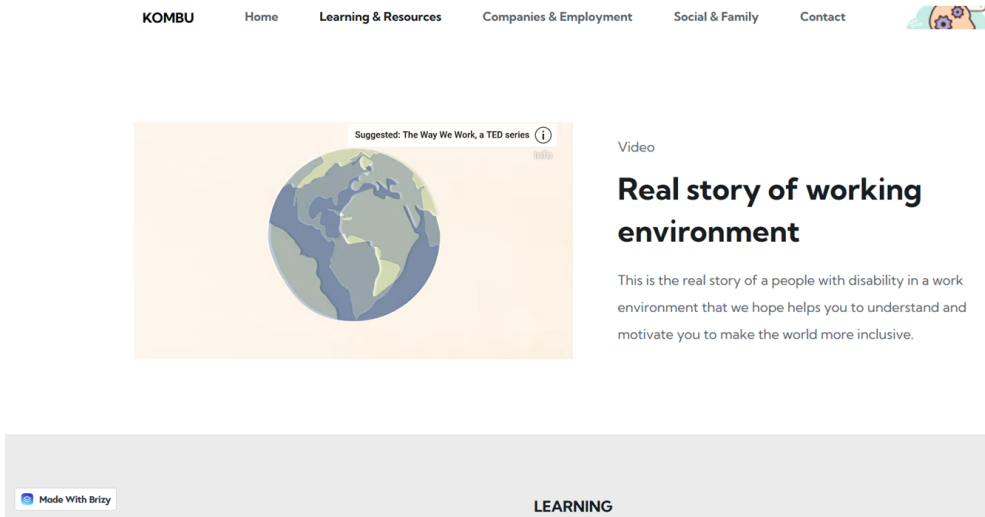
Website structure and purpose

Within these three pillars there are different subareas. In the learning and resources section we can access online training in different subjects, online training in applications and new technologies to overcome barriers to accessing training, as well as different audio-books and teaching materials.

The business and social parts are, in turn, divided by types of disability, containing a series of advice and tips for companies and social and family environments, respectively, that help the integration of people with disabilities.

How is the website solving addressing the cause/industry problem.

One of the main causes that people with disabilities cannot effectively develop the different areas of their life, social and family, educational and work, is due to the widespread ignorance that exists about disability.

Educational resources are not accessible to everyone, in-person training is not always an option, and online training, in general, is designed for the "normative" generality. As for companies, normally they do not know what the inclusion of personnel with disabilities can bring to their team, how to make the job accessible so that they can perform it optimally or how they should relate to other colleagues.

Finally, in the family and social sphere, there is a general taboo when talking about disability, which means that the needs of people with disabilities are not known; how they should be treated, how to relate to them and, In short, how to make them participate in

this area. Therefore, this resource aims to bring companies and closer disability environments to the existing resources and tools that value these people, facilitating their inclusion in all areas of life.
